Portfolio Assets: As of February 29, 2012, Georgia Fund 1 net assets totaled \$8,910,147,872 and were invested in 35.18% overnight repurchase agreements, 24.83% collateralized bank accounts, 32.69% federal agency/instrumentality securities, 2.81% term repurchase agreements, and 4.49% overnight commercial paper. The average portfolio maturity on that date was 46 days.
