Georgia Fund 1 is the combined state general fund and local government investment pool managed by the Office of the State Treasurer. Georgia Fund 1 was formerly referred to as the "LGIP". Georgia Fund 1 is a money market fund rated AAAm by Standard & Poor's.

<u>Portfolio Assets:</u> As of July 31, 2012, Georgia Fund 1 net assets totaled \$8,275,958,368 and were invested in 30.03% overnight repurchase agreements, 33.54% collateralized bank accounts, 28.57% federal agency/instrumentality securities, 3.02% term repurchase agreements, and 4.84% overnight commercial paper. The average portfolio maturity on that date was 51 days.
